of your Royal Highness's Permission, he has
had a Conversation with Mr Percival respecting

which have been so judiciously adopted
by the Gov^r Gen^l of India, for extinguishing
the remains of the French Power in that
Quarter appears to give his Lordship a
fair Claim to some Mark of Your Royal

Make an additional step in the same,
by creating him a baronet (as soon as the
restrictions upon the Regency shall have expired)
may be considered as under all the
circumstances of the case, the most advisable
mode of effecting the purpose.

Lord Liverpool humbly therefore submits
to your Royal Highness, whether you will
be graciously pleased to permit him
to inform Lord Minto that as soon as
the restrictions on the Regency have ceased
It is your Royal Highness's intention,
as a mark of the same which you
intend of his Public Services to

create upon him the Rank of a baronet
of the United Kingdom
