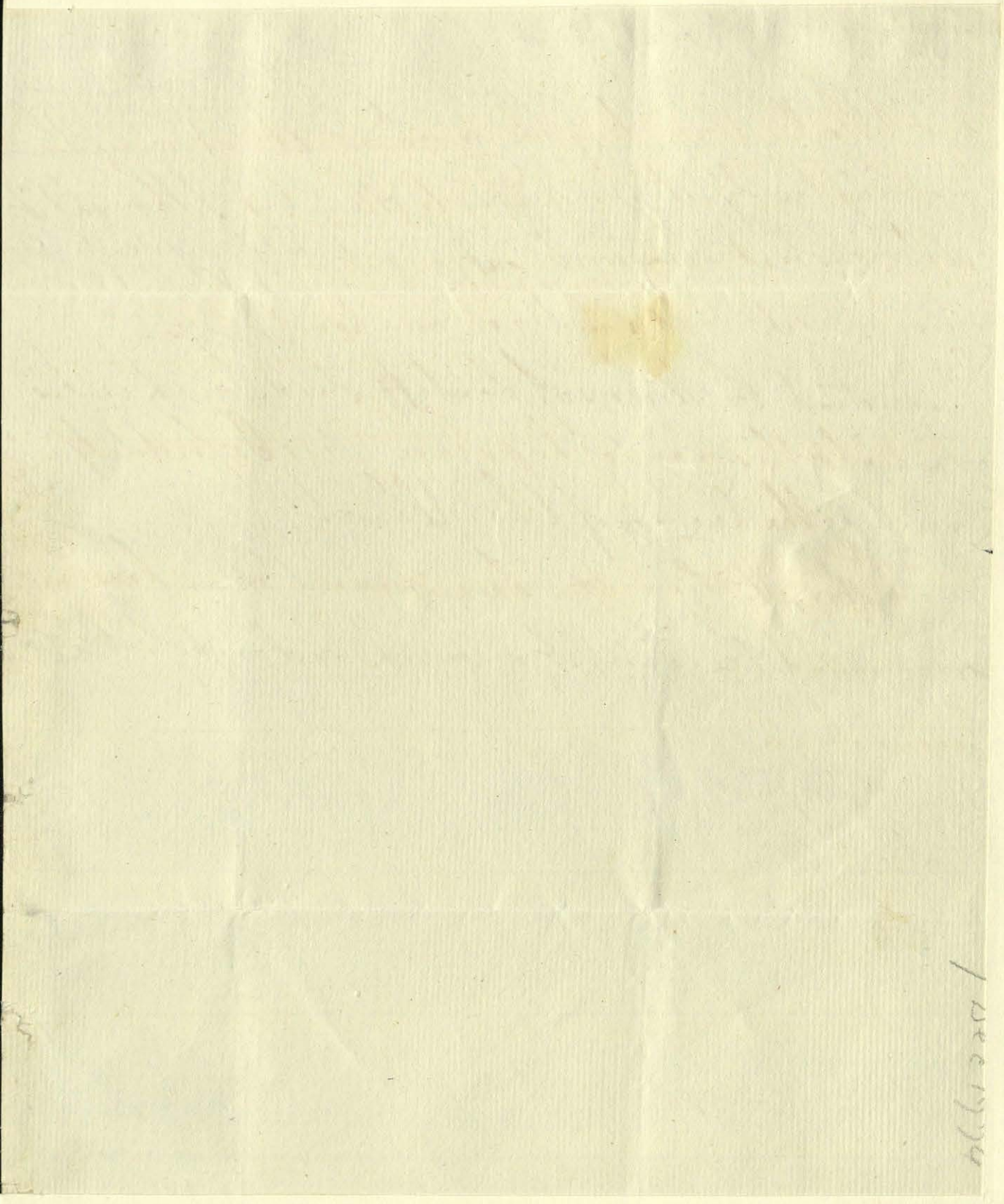
I understand the Bishop of Landaff stands much in his own light this may perhaps ease Your Obedience difficulties concerning the Canonry of Christ Church.
