We cannot but feel highly gratified by the kindness of the motive on which Lord Moira acts. Personal communication with him will always be acceptable & honorable to us, but we hope he will be sensible that no advantage is likely to result from pursuing this subject by unauthorized discussions & in a course so different from the usual practice.

Motives of obvious delicacy must prevent our taking any step towards determining the Prince Regent to authorize Lord Moira to address us personally. We shall always receive, with dutiful submission, His Royal Highness's Commands in whatever manner & through whatever channel he may be pleased to signify them, and we trust

we shall never be found wanting
in Zeal for His Royal Highness
service & for the Public Interest.
But we cannot venture to
suggest to His Royal Highness
through any other person, our
opinions on points on which
His Royal Highness is not pleased
to require our advice.
