

Sir R. Barclay to Col. Mc Mahon

Private 20105 Fulham Sunday Morning
4 Oct 1812

My Dear Friend,

as I did not go to Town Yesterday,
Mr Tritton the Banker sent me the
inclosed. I think it proper to give
you this early Notice of Lord Castlereagh's
determination as to the Appointment
to Russia. Mr Brogden my Brother
Director at the Bank had told me
on Thursday, that he thought Mr Bayley
would be appointed Consul, as he had
been recommended to Lord Castlereagh
by Lords Powis, & St Helens: —
