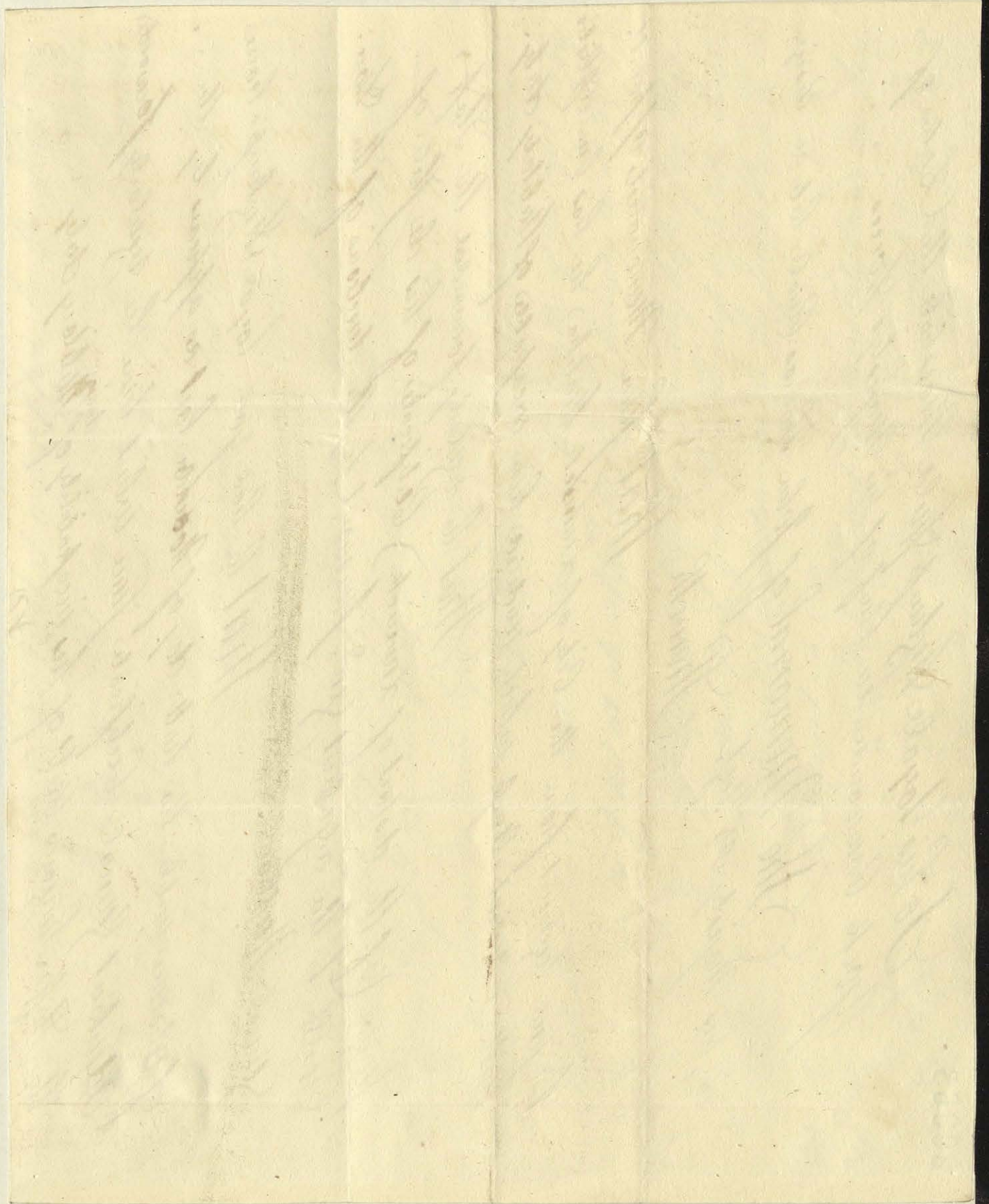

Sheweth That said Memorialist appointed
to said Regiment from the City of Lincoln (where he has been afflicted
with a violent Croup which rendered him incapable of Military duty.

That he regularly forwarded the Staff
Surgeon (of the district of Lincoln) Certificate of his ill state of
Health to the adjutant Genl. pursuant to the directions of the Hon:
General Medlow

That he had your Royal Highness's leave
of absence until the tenth day of November last as appears by the
Adjutant General's Certificate since which time he regularly forwarded
the Staff Surgeon's Cert. of his incapability of ^{doing} Military duty

That it will appear by the Staff
Surgeon's Cert. dated the eighth day of Decr. last (and forwarded to
the adjutant Genl. that Memorialist is not yet sufficiently recovered to
join said Regiment

That Memorialist has shown & produced
to Major Genl. Darby (the General commanding the Lincoln District)
the Letter of his appointment General Letter from the Honble General
Medlow Mesp^r. Greenwood Esq. (and also the Cert. of your Royal Highness
leave of absence as herein before stated

Notwithstanding the above Circumstances
Memorialist has been unduly returned in the Gazette of the eighth day of
December last as if not at all appointed to an Ensigny in D. Regt.

Memorialist therefore humbly hopes for the
various favors your Royal Highness will take his Acc
into Consideration and restore him to his former Rank in said
Regiment

New Year's Eve Dec. 31. 1812

Having laid before the Commanders in Chief your Letter of the
1st instant for forwarding a Memorial from Mr. Lachale late
an Ensign in 60th Regt. I am directed to acquaint you that as
that Gentleman never joined or in any manner served the
Commission to which he was appointed he was necessarily
discontinued as an Officer in the Army and above upon such
Certificates can only be granted to those who have claims to such
medals from previous service
