Although I shall see you on Thursday I think it right to say that I put the matter in Train as to Perry - and I shall see the person whom I entrusted with it on Thursday at five o'clock sharp result.

It appeared to me that James intended to send not to come but Macond's resolution agreed with mine that he was appointed - & I did so state it to him. He came without his papers but he said they were all separated & ready for delivery.

I have been arranging in my Head a Method by which all your concerns at Bend's as well as the Bond shall be cleared away — in a short time.
