It is with the greatest reluctance  
I am under the necessity of requesting  
Your Royal Highness will permit  
me to resign the situation in  
Your Royal Highness's Household  
which you were so graciously  
pleas'd to confer on me.

I have been compelled  
to come to this determination by the  
manner in which I have been treated,  
and the unsatisfactory answer I have  
received from His Majesty's Ministers  
in reply to the statement I had the  
honour of laying before Your Royal

convey'd to me thro' Col<sup>l</sup> the Baron.

to your Royal Highness's Command and  
most humble service
