Declaration of the  
Members of Her  
Majesty's Council  
respecting the State  
of His Majesty's  
Health.

We the underwritten Members of the Council appointed to assist Her Majesty in the Execution of the Trusts committed to Her Majesty by virtue of the Statute passed in the Fifty first Year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled an act to provide for the Administration of the Royal Authority, and for the Care of His Majesty's Royal Person during the Continuance of His Majesty's Illness and for the Resumption of the Exercise of the Royal Authority by His Majesty, having duly met together on this third Day of July 1813 at The Queen's Lodge near to Windsor Castle, and having called before us, and examined upon Oath, the Physicians, and other Persons attendant upon His Majesty, and having ascertained the State of His Majesty's Health by all such other ways and means as appeared to us to be necessary for that purpose, Do hereby Declare and certify, That the State of His Majesty's Health at the Time of this our Meeting, is not such as to enable Him to resume the personal Exercise of His Royal Authority. His Majesty's bodily

Health is good. His Majesty's mental  
Health is not improved since our last  
Report. His Majesty's Recovery is  
not expected by his Physicians.

They do not absolutely despair  
of His Majesty's Recovery, which they  
represent as not impossible.
