Understanding that it is the intention of the Prince Regent that, on the departure of the seventh Muspars, the Cavalry duty in London should be done by Detachments from the Regiments of Life Guards & from the Royal Regiment of Horse Guards, I request the favour of you to most humbly submit to His Royal Highness that a Detachment of one Field Officer & one hundred Men with a proportionate number of Officer from the 1st Life Guards should be ordered into Hyde Barracks on the removal of the Muspars from thence - I have the honor to be,
