We the Underwritten Members of
the Council appointed to Assist
Her Majesty in the execution of
the Trusts committed to Her Majesty
by virtue of the Statute passed in
the 55th Year of His Majesty's Reign
intituled "An Act to provide for
" the Administration of the Royal
" Authority, and for the Care of His
" Majesty's Royal Person during the
" Continuance of His Majesty's Illness
" and for the Resumption of the Exercise
" of the Royal Authority by His
" Majesty" having duly met
together on this Second Day of
October 1813 at the Queens Lodge
near to Windsor Castle, and
having called before Us and
examined upon both the Physicians
and other Persons attendant upon
His Majesty, and having
ascertained the State of His
Majesty's Health by all such

other

other ways and Means as appeared
 to us to be necessary for that purpose
 Do hereby Declare and Certify
 That the state of His Majesty's
 Health at the time of this our
 Meeting is; That the present
 state of His Majesty's Health
 is, not such as to enable His
 Majesty to resume the Personal
 Exercise of His Royal Authority.
 His Majesty's bodily Health is
 good and unimpaired.

His Majesty's mental Health
 is as much disordered as at any
 time during His Indisposition

His Majesty's Recovery is
 not expected by His Physicians.

They represent themselves as
 not absolutely despairing of
 His

His Majesty's Recovery continuing
to state, That His Recovery is not
impossible. —
