His R.H. the Prince Regent commanded me to request of you to signify to Lord Liverpool A.M.H. wish that the road of plantation, ^{as shown in plan} shown by the annexed plan should be immediately carried into effect — I saw Mr Harrison on the subject who suggested that the regular mode on this and all such occasions is to address the Prince Regent's pleasure to Lord Liverpool individually who will thereupon cause the necessary minutes to be made by the Board of Treasury.

I apprehend something like the enclosed letter clad in your better terms and accompanied with the enclosed plan will produce the authority wanted.

I have only to add that the season for planting will not admit of delay.
