Prince Regent having taken into consideration the situation of  
His Majesty's Wounded Soldiers, does in the name and on behalf of  
His Majesty extend His Majesty's Warrant of the 25<sup>th</sup> of October  
1806, to all Out Pensioners of Chelsea Hospital in the following  
proportions, viz. *[flourish]*

To every Serjeant who shall have lost more than one	} <i>per Diem</i>	0 - 3 - 6
or be otherwise rendered incapable of earning their Bread Limb, a rate of Pension not exceeding		
To every Corporal - Ditto	Ditto	0 - 3 - 0
To every Private - Ditto	Ditto	0 - 2 - 6

Instructions have been given to the Commissioners of Chelsea Hospital  
to govern themselves accordingly.
