Sir

Somerset Place 4th May 1844

Until the arrival of your letter yesterday, I supposed Mr. Joseph Lancaster to continue in the superintendance of the Free School in St. George's Fields, for the benefit and support of which I have been accustomed to pay to him His Royal Highness The Prince Regent's annual subscription; and it was for that purpose, and not for his own personal use, that the sum of one hundred pounds, paid by me to Mr. Lancaster on 25th of April last, was intended.
