We the underwritten Members of the Council appointed to assist Her Majesty in the Execution of the Trusts committed to Her Majesty by virtue of the Statute passed in the Fifty first Year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act to provide for the Administration of the Royal Authority and for the care of His Majesty's Royal Person during the continuance of His Majesty's Illness, and for the Resumption of the Exercise of the Royal Authority by His Majesty" having duly met together, on this Seventh day of January 1815 at The Queen's Lodge near Windsor Castle, and having called before Us and examined upon Oath the Physicians and other Persons attendant upon His Majesty, and having ascertained the State of His Majesty's Health by all such other ways and means as appeared to us to be necessary for that purpose, Do hereby declare and certify.

that the state of His Majesty's health
at the time of this our Meeting
is not such as to enable His
Majesty to resume the personal
Exercise of His Royal Authority.
His Majesty's bodily Health is
good. His Majesty's mental
Health is as much disordered,
as at any period of His
Majesty's Illness. His Majesty's
Physicians do not expect His
recovery. They state themselves
as not altogether despairing of
it, because such Recovery is
not impossible.
