Copy of Sir Tom Manners's reply to Col^l M^cMahon's Letter
of 22nd August 1815

"Colonel M^cMahon will be troubled no further - money being no object none will ever be received in the way of compensation as offered. The promise of a Pension might to be performed, & unless it is performed within a reasonable period, copies of the letter will be sent to every Peer & Member of Parliament, some of whom would be glad to bring forward such a transaction."

Lord Liverpool has been written to on the matter.
