Ld Liverpool has the honor to inform  
your Royal Highness that Mr. Martin arrived  
early this morning with the second  
drafts of Conventions between the Allies  
and the French for the Restoration  
and Maintenance of Peace, signed at  
Paris on Monday last.

These Drafts have been read in Council  
this Day they are quite conformable  
to the Protocols which your Royal  
Highness has already seen and approved  
and Ld Liverpool has no doubt  
they will be considered by the Nation  
in general as satisfactory.

Ld Liverpool ~~was~~

to leave Paris this day, or tomorrow  
and send Lord Liverpool's papers to be able  
to meet him at Malmaison on Sunday  
Lord Liverpool understands it is your  
Royal Highness's intention to return  
to town on Saturday, and he will  
have the honor of paying his duty to  
your Royal Highness and of waiting  
your Royal Highness's commands  
on Sunday morning
