said office, together with all Rights, Profits, Privileges and

and Seal at Carlton House this _____ Day of
One Thousand Eight hundred and six in the Forty sixth year of His
Majestys Reign
By the Prince Himself.

When any of the Chaplains may have the opportunity of enjoying
two livings the above appointment will be received and Registered
at the Faculty Office, and in consequence, it has been agreed that
His Grace the arch Bishop of Canterbury will grant the dispensation
for holding two livings, and it is also understood without any limitation
as to the Number of His Royal Highness's Chaplains: as is Explained
by a Copy of Lord Southampton's Letter to The Rev. D^r. Lockman,
Clerk of the Closet, the 23rd Janry 1789. together with the ground of objection
made at the Faculty office. which occasioned it.

Copy of a Letter from The Right Hon^{ble}. Lord Southampton
Groom of the Stole to His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales
To the Rev. D^r. Lockman Clerk of the Closet To His Royal Highness.
Carlton House 23rd Janry 1789.

Sir

I have settled with His Grace the arch Bishop of Canterbury, that
in future all warrants of appointments of Chaplains to His Royal

Highness The Prince of Wales shall be signed, as those of His Majesty's are usually signed & sealed by the first officer of His Household, and not to be limited in number, but that whenever any of H. R. Highness's Chaplains (so appointed by warrant of His Groom of the Stole, or other officer at the Head of His Household) wishes to enjoy the Privileges annexed to his office a fresh warrant shall be made out, signed & sealed by His Royal Highness, which will be received at the Faculty office & in consequence His Grace the Arch Bishop of Canterbury will grant the dispensation for the holding of two Livings.

The above Letter was occasioned by objections made at the Faculty Office, and His Royal Highness The Prince of Wales's appointment of Chaplains having been refused to be Registered, on alledged Informality; grounded on the following Clause in an Act 21 Hen: 8. C 13 & 22. Viz. "Provided always, that
"The said Chaplains so purchasing, taking, receiving and keeping
"Benefices with Cure of Souls, as is aforesaid, shall be bound
"to have & Exhibit, where need shall be, Letters under y^e Sign
"and Seal of y^e King, or other their Lord & Master, testifying
"whose Chaplains they be, & else not to enjoy any such pluralities
"of Benefices, by being such Chaplains"
His Royal Highness to accomodate the Rev^d John Marshall signed & sealed the qualification required at the office, without waiving His Privilege as Prince of Wales of appointing (without limitation) any number of Chaplains. In consequence therefore of the Arch Bishop of Canterbury's acquiescence & Conformation of H. R. H's Established Right to retain such unlimited number H. R. H's so far agrees to the mode of appointment as explained in Lord Southampton's Letter.

Orders for Attendance at Carlton House
 by the Prince of Wales's Command

The Gentlemen of the Household are desired to be made acquainted, and wish'd to observe, that H. R. H. has been pleas'd to direct (whenever the King goes to the House of Lords) in future, such officers as shall be in waiting do give a regular and early attendance at Carlton House, and wait of absence on indisposition, H. R. H. objects them to give timely information to one of the Lords of the Treasury, what other officers of their respective ranks are in attendance for them, that the sooner they may be at the disposal to whom they are to apply.

This latter part of H. R. H.'s Command is to be understood as a general order in all attendances whatsoevers.

They direct to make remembrance that H. R. H. has had access to the Prince of Wales's box at the Play, not from any of his appointments but from immediate favours of H. R. H. by his Majesty's Command, that will prevent the precedent.
