They came to acquaint your Royal
 Highness that Prince had received a letter from
 my Brother on the Subject of Baron Osterle's
 Enquiries with some additional Illustrations - There
 are some Enclosures in it, which I have

referred to 2^d Hamilton to translate - The whole
 shall be submitted to your Royal Highness as soon
 as the translations are completed - as our hope
 is that they will not produce any Essential Change
 in the Instructions lately sent to Lord Stewart, your
 Royal Highness may possibly however authorize me
 to communicate them to the Lord Chancellor, with
 a view of considering, whether in the absence of the
 Prince of Wales from home, the Examiner should
 be sent, or whether a legal agent should be sent out
 to assist ^{in conducting it} - perhaps with a view to a complete explanation
 the former might be the better course, but this will
 require a more patient examination of the Documents
 than I have been able to bestow upon them
