My dear Mr. Maitland

I think it just right to say that by a letter I received yesterday it appears Her Royal Highness The Princess of Wales arrived at Malta in a small Polacca Ship on the 28th April from Tunis -

It further appears that she declined landing - and nobody knows where she intended to steer her course on leaving Malta, which she was to do as soon as she had got some Vegetables &c on board - In all this I shall make no observation -

I have just got a famous batch of Marashino and shall send a quantity home by the first favorable opportunity -

These Islands are the most desperate Job I ever undertook - And I do not despair of seeing you in Town as I think I shall probably be forced to go home before matters are finally settled in regard to them -
