Sir George Campbell is a very

Cawdor has always been in Opposition,
and he himself, as I believe, always
voted against Government till he vacated
his Seat in favor of Lord Cawdor's eldest
son - if I could understand that the
Family Politics had rendering one any
change I could have no objection to

but it is a serious evil to Government,
and eventually to His Royal Highness;
to profess our Friends and to promote
enemies - general Edward Capel has
certainly no political claims whatever.
I have no desire to press Sir John
Beresford's pretensions if his nomination

Regent - I think it right however to
observe that his Baronage was not
given to him as a political favor, but
partly on the ground of his general
professional services, and more especially
