The Marquis of Hastings to your Royal
Highness, which Lord Liverpool has
received from Sir B Bloomfield.

Lord Liverpool understands from Sir
B Bloomfield, that this letter contains
an application to your Royal Highness for
the Order of the Garter, and Sir B Bloomfield
considered himself well properly not
the proper Channel of such an
application.

Lord Liverpool has not thought himself
justified

justified in withholding or delaying the
Letter, but he humbly requests Your
Royal Highness would not return
an answer to the Application, until
after a further communication with
Lord Liverpool.

Lord Liverpool has never held out
any expectations of the Order of the Garter
to any Person, which could entitle
Your Royal Highness.

Your Royal Highness will recollect
the authority for your Lordship's
in the last Enquiry, to inform the Duke
of Northumberland, that his Grace's
Claims to this Distinction would be
