4. The sum of £17,000 remaining unpaid on the loan of £20,000 on the Docks of Admiralty to be relinquished.

5. A suitable House to be provided for His Royal Highness's Residence in Town with Furniture &c

Any necessary repairs according to existing regulations but no expense can be incurred on account of the Public for Furniture.

6. The House at Bushy to be repaired.
