I have the honor to acquaint
Your Lordship that the Com-
missioners appointed by His Royal
Highness The Prince Regent to
open the Box in the Crown
Room within the Castle of
Edinburgh supposed to contain
the Regalia of Scotland, pro-
ceeded on Wednesday last to
perform the duty entrusted to
them; and that I have this day
received information that the
whole Regalia were found,
exactly in the state described
in an official document made
out in the year 1707 at the
time of their deposalation

The statement transmitted to me is extremely short, being written immediately before the departure of the Post and while the Commissioners were yet in the Crown Room; but the different articles found are described as being in high preservation, and the Crown in particular sufficiently splendid to satisfy not only National but even Jacobinical vanity, should any such yet remain in the Country

I would have delayed making this communication to your Lordship until the official Report of the proceedings of the Commissioners had been

received; but having understood that
His Royal Highness The Prince
Regent was graciously Pleas'd
to take an interest in the search
which has been made by His Royal
Command, I have conceived it my
duty to enable Your Lordship,
should you think it proper, to
acquaint His Royal Highness
that it has proved successful
