Declaration of Her
Majesty's Council

We the Underwritten Members of the
Council appointed to Assist Her Majesty
in the Execution of the Trusts committed
to Her Majesty by virtue of the Statute
passed in the Fifty first Year of His
Majesty's Reign, entitled, "An Act to provide
for the Administration of the Royal Authority,
and for the Care of His Majesty's Royal
Person during the Continuance of His
Majesty's Illness, and for the Resumption
of the Exercise of the Royal Authority by
His Majesty, having duly met together on
this fourth Day of April 1818, at the Queens
Lodge, near to Windsor Castle, and having
called before Us, and examined upon both
the Physicians, and other persons attendant
upon His Majesty, and having ascertained
the State of His Majesty's Health, by all such
other ways and means as appeared to Us
to be necessary for that Purpose, do hereby
declare and Certify, That the State of His
Majesty's

Majesty's health at the time of
this our Meeting is not such as
to enable His Majesty to resume
the personal Exercise of His
Royal Authority. His Majesty's
mental Health continuing as
much disordered as at any time
during his Indisposition. His
Majesty's bodily health is very
good.

His Majesty's Physicians
represent that it is only because
it is not impossible that His
Majesty should recover, that they
do not despair of His recovery, but
they do not expect that His
Majesty will recover.
