We the Underwritten Members of  
the Council appointed to assist  
His Royal Highness Frederick  
Duke of York and Albany in the  
Execution of the Trusts committed  
to His Royal Highness by virtue of  
the Statute passed in the 59<sup>th</sup> Year  
of His Majesty's Reign intituled,  
"An Act to provide for the care of  
His Majesty's Royal Person during  
the continuance of His Majesty's  
Illness", having duly met together  
on this third day of July 1819 in  
the Castle at Windsor, and having  
called before Us and examined  
upon Oath the Physicians and  
other Persons attendant upon His  
Majesty, and having ascertained  
the State of His Majesty's Health  
by all such other ways and means  
as appeared to Us to be necessary  
for that purpose, Do hereby declare

and

and certify that the State of His Majesty's Health at the time of this our Meeting is not such as to enable Him to resume the personal Exercise of His Royal Authority. That His Majesty's bodily Health is good. That His Majesty's mental Disorder continues without abatement. That His Majesty's Physicians do not expect His Recovery but that they do not despair of His Majesty's Recovery, only because it is not impossible.
