Windsor August 11th 1819—

At a meeting of the Committee for Rebuilding the
Parish Church of New Windsor

The Chairman communicated a letter which
he had received from General Taylor, in answer to one
sent by him by order of the last meeting. —

It is resolved that the Chairman do return the following
reply to General Taylor's letter. —

The Committee in reply to General Taylor's
communication, beg to inform him that unless two
thirds of the estimated Expense for Building the Church
be raised by subscription, they could not recommend
burthening the Parish with a larger sum than would
then be wanted to make up the deficiency. —

The Repair of the present Church was
first contemplated by the Parish in Vestry, and
decided by the opinion of Surveyors that it could
not be repaired. —

Resolution of the

The Money raised for Building the New Church cannot be appropriated to the Repairs of the Old Church should it be considered by any new Survey that its Repair is practicable. — All Sums contributed are invested in Government Securities — and all contributors will have their Subscriptions returned to them if the amount should prove unequal to the Building of the Church. —

Resolved that the Secretary do address Letters to the Prince Regent and the other Members of the Royal Family, through the proper channels, to renew the application heretofore made for their Subscriptions, except those to whom General Taylor has undertaken to apply.
