The Archbishop of Canterbury humbly submits to His Royal Highness the Prince Regent the substance of the Report made this day by His Royal Highness & Duke of York's Council to His Majesty's most honorable Privy Council respecting His Majesty's health. "The Council certify & declare that the state of His Majesty's health at the time of their meeting is not such as to enable Him to resume the personal exercise of His Royal Authority that His Majesty's bodily health is good that His Majesty's mental disorder continues without abatement, that His Majesty's Physicians do not expect His Majesty's recovery, but that they do not despair of His Majesty's recovery only because it is not impossible.
