The King has, by this morning's Post, received a letter from Lt. Colonel Doyle: The King feels it necessary to put Lord Liverpool in possession of its contents previous to Lord Liverpool's interview with Lt. Col. Doyle - The King therefore sends Sir B. Worsley to make this confidential communication to Lord Liverpool, together with a copy of the King's answer to Lt. Col. Doyle. - Sir B. Worsley is empowered to express the King's further sentiments to Lord Liverpool, accompanied by a further private correspondence, which
