Lord Sandwich has the honour to forward Sir Hugh Pallipers letter just now received, which contains every thing that relates to the fleet at Portsmouth, which it is feared will not be able to sail to day as the wind is too far to the westward.

The Comptroller of the Navy has just been here and says they have a letter from Bremerdeke which mentions that the last three transports were arrived, so that there is nothing now to hinder the two Regiments of Hessians from sailing with the first fair wind.
