Lord Aclen & M. Gen. Taylor have the
Honor humbly to report to The Prince Regent
that They have been busily engaged in the
Arrangement and Valuation of Her late
Majesty's Jewels, and have made some
Progress in the Division of them into
into four Lots preparatory to a Distribution
— They have packed up the Jewels in Windsor
Castle for Removal to London, in Order to

collect

collect them with those from the Bank, for
Mr. Bridges's valuation in The Queen's Palace;
and above all for His Royal Highness's
Inspection there. — They flatter themselves
that after next week their arrangements
at Windsor will be in a sufficient state
of forwardness to admit of their attending
His Royal Highness in London whenever
it shall suit His Convenience to honor
them with His Commands. —

They hope they shall be forgiven for
expressing their anxiety to learn the Nature
and Extent of the Claim which may be preferred
in Behalf of the King to any of Her late Majesty's

Jewels, either as being considered His Majesty's
 Private Property, or Property in Right of the
 Crown. — They are aware that by Her Majesty's
 will, a Proportion therein specified, is left to
 The King, but They have understood that Her
 Majesty's Property in those given to Her by
 the Jacob of Arcot, is questioned also, & that
 a similar Doubt is entertained respecting
 some other of the Jewels given at various
 times by The King, to The Queen. — They are
 confident His Royal Highness will
 graciously consider that it is Their Duty
 as Executors to endeavour to learn the
 precise Grounds, upon which the Exception
 is taken, and the Distinction made, that They
 may

may be enabled to solicit the Opinion of the Lord
Chancellor, in a matter in which they cannot ven-
ture to act upon their own Judgment. —

With respect to those given by the Nabob
of Arcot, they have already applied to the Chair-
man of the Court of Directors of the East India
Company, for such Information as their Records
may furnish, towards throwing Light upon
this Point, to be likewise submitted
to the Lord Chancellor. —

Lots, will be reserved for His Royal Highness's
Inspection there, ^{at his convenience,} previous to their being de-
posited, Mr. Bridge having mentioned to them
that it was His Royal Highness's Desire
to see them.
