I beg leave to acknowledge your Note of this morning, and in answer to it respecting the Pompeii.

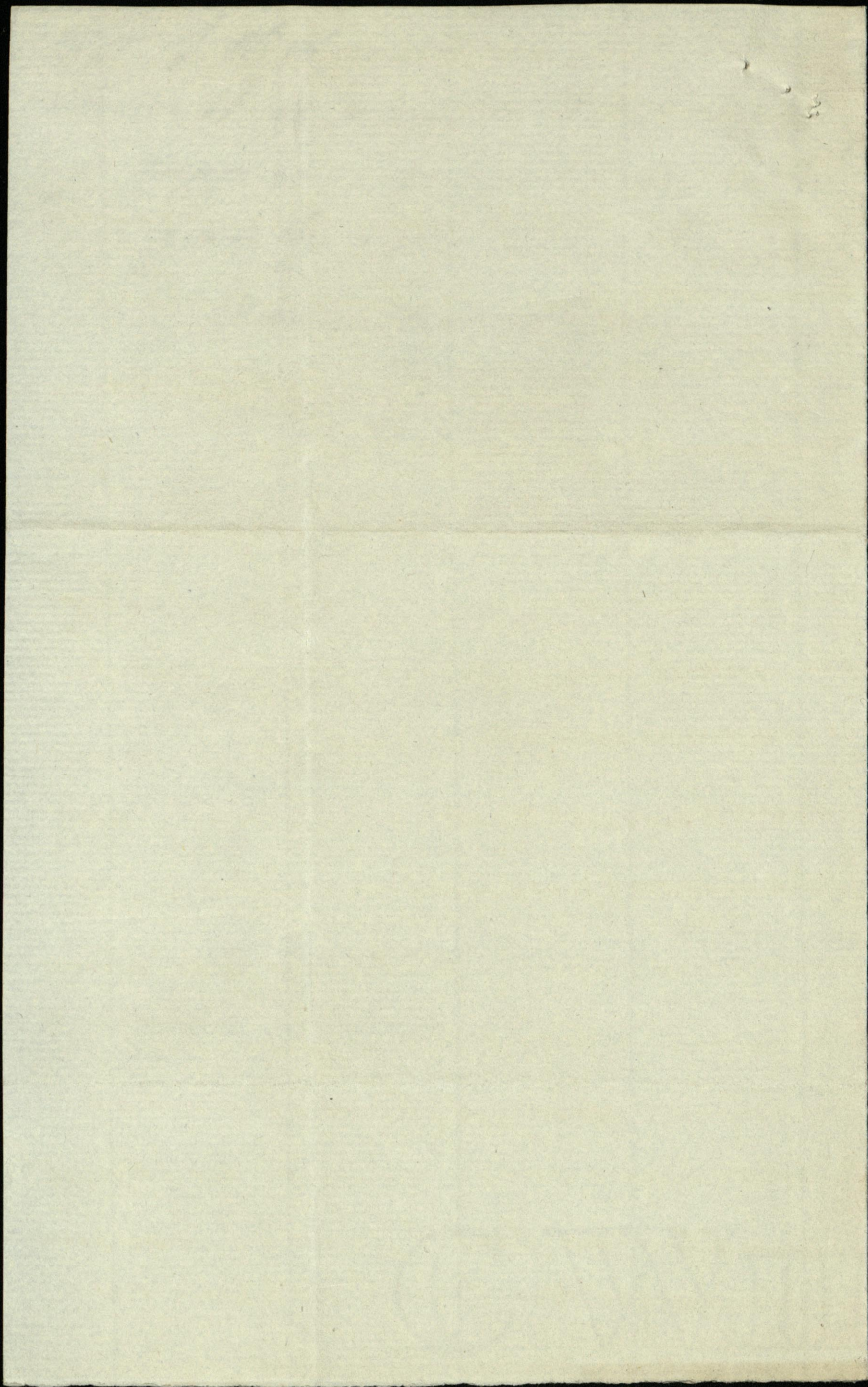
