21 " New best Musquet as a pattern with
hoops on bands over the barrel & stock
a large hollow in beech pin sight
on fore hoop & on Bayonet spring on
loop of barrel to hold on the Bayonet
holes in the plate of the lock to hold up the
spring while the works are cleaned, high
hammer to prevent the thumb from being cut
by the flint & gives velocity to throw the ham-
mer back, the barrel & bayonet socket browned
and the lock in hardened colour.

To another light Musquet with wire loops
hollow in beech pin high hammer
browning barrel bayonet socket
