Lord George Germain upon looking over
the appointments of the Judges in Canada
with Lieutenant General Haldimand finds
it more proper to recommend to your
Majesty that Mr. Graves should succeed
William Owen in the Court of Common
Pleas in Montreal. if your Majesty approves
of the Alteration you will be pleas'd to
insert the name of William Owen over
that of Edward Southwell which is scratched
out. Lord George sends the Commission for
Mr. Graves which your Majesty orders.
