Lord North cannot be surpris'd at my indignation at the number of persons who so shamefully avoided attending Yesterday which made the Majority so much less than it ought to have been; I trust you will get an accurate list of the Absent that every means may be tried to get their attendance on future occasions. The Opposition seem to have had the Numbers I have frequently heard you mention they would muster viz 170.

If you can devise any means I can personally take to assist in getting Persons to attend better you will find me most ready to adopt it.
