Lord Sandwich takes the liberty to submit to your Majesty whether it might not have a good effect if your Majesty was to allow Sir James Wallace the honour of an audience after the Levee on Friday; he has nothing to ask for himself, & Lord Sandwich thinks that he would consider the honour of being admitted to your Majesty's presence, as an ample reward for his very distinguished services; Sir James Wallace however has not the least idea that such an honour can be conferred upon him.
