In obedience to Your Majesty's commands I  
communicated the contents of the note, with  
which Your Majesty honor'd me, to the Cabinet,  
in consequence of which an alteration has  
been made in the Instructions by leaving out  
the words to return for reinforcement it was  
thought that this alteration would make  
the draught agreeable to Your Majesty's  
commands, & that Sir Charles Hardy would  
be left to act entirely on his own Judgment  
without any bias.
