Lord Sandwich has the honour to inform your Majesty that he has seen Sir William Gordon, & that he finds from conversing with him that he has no authentick information of any meeting or agreement made between any of your Majesty's servants to support L^d Weymouth North; but that he thinks they intend to do so from appearances, & from the language of persons who are pretty well informed.

L^d Sandwich pressed him closely to know whether any of those persons were Lord Chancellor, L^d Gower, or Lord Weymouth, he answered in the negative; and your Majesty may depend that he told L^d S. all he knew, and that his intelligence is little better than common report.
