Since I wrote to your Majesty I find that Mr Robinson was mistaken in supposing that the Lords went into the Committee on the Militia Bill last night & made the Amendment; They adjourned the Consideration of it till today. Your Majesty will be pleased to observe that the Bill, as it stands at present, does not order the Militia to be doubled, but leaves it in your Majesty's power to augment it in any proportion, as the occasion may require
