July 16 1779

Lord George Germain upon his return from
St James's yesterday received the enclosed
letter from Sir William Pepperell with
a copy of an Address to your Majesty
from many loyal American Subjects
which they desire to present. If your
Majesty will be pleased to receive it
this day at the levee, a Committee
is appointed to attend with it. If your
Majesty wishes it to be presented Lord
George will signify your Majesty's Command
to the Gentlemen of the Committee.
