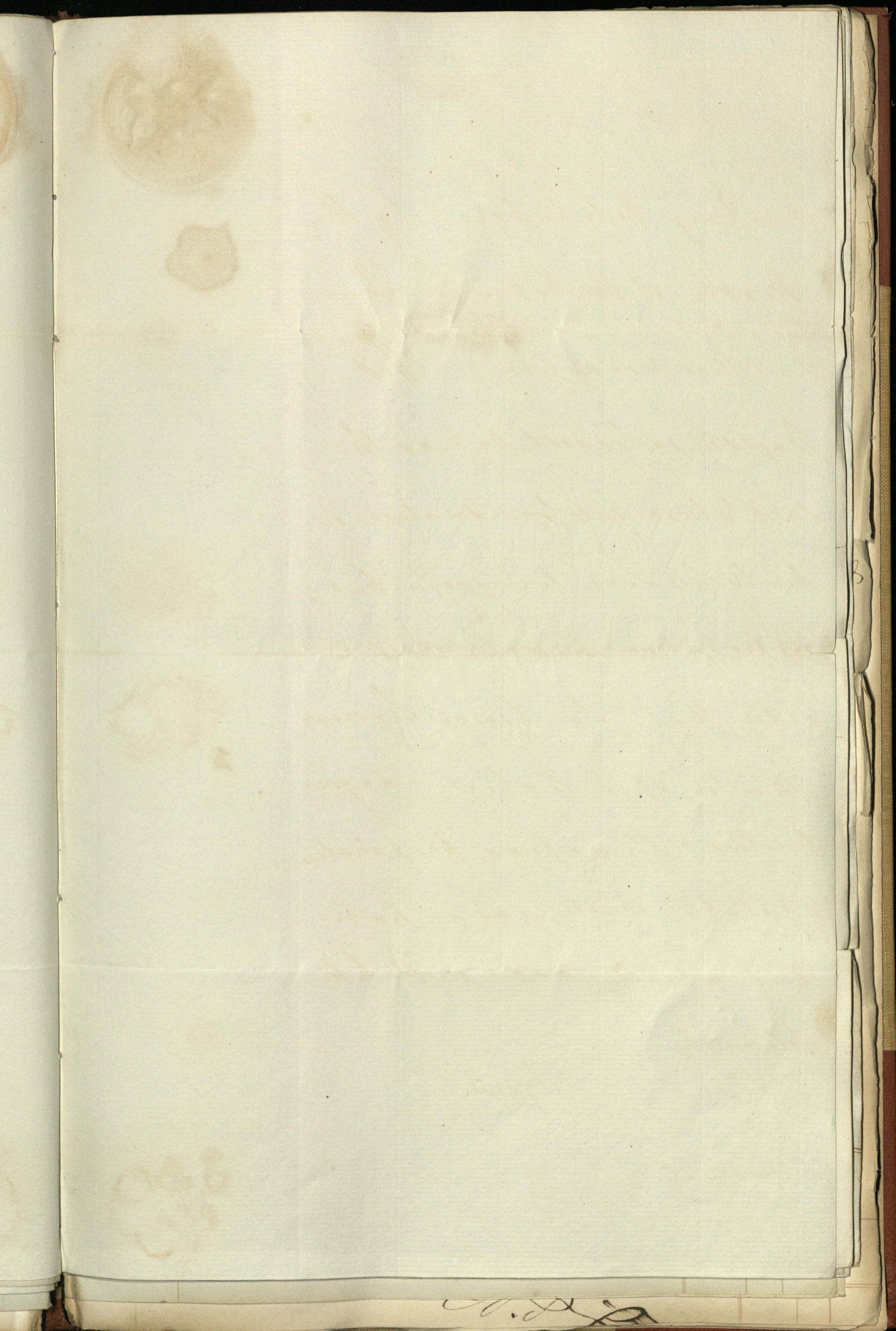
The King's most Excellent Majesty
