In pursuance of an Order of His Majesty in Council,
These are to signify to you that you do provide such
Royal Robes as are called Parliament Robes, and
are to be used by the King's most Excellent
Majesty at his Coronation, that is to say, a
Kirtle or Surcoat of Crimson Velvet, with a large
Mantle and Hood of the same furred with
Ermine and bordered with rich gold lace, a
Cap of Estate turned up with Ermine, and Robes
of State of Purple Velvet of the same Fashion as
the other, also a Cap of purple Velvet turned
up with Ermine for His Majesty's Crown:
all which several particulars you are to cause
to be made and fitted for His Majesty's use
against the day of His Majesty's Coronation.
And for so doing this shall be your Warrant.

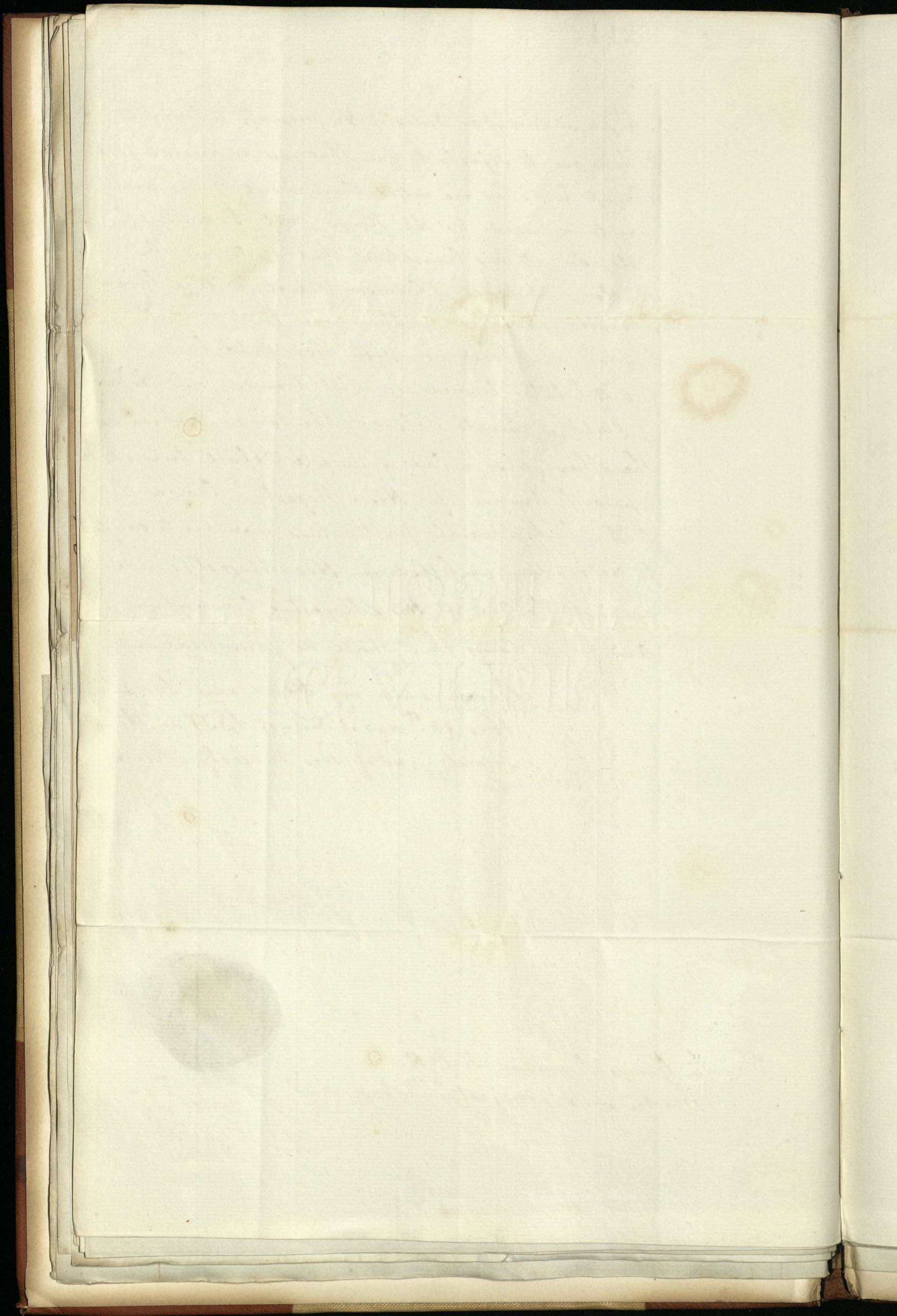

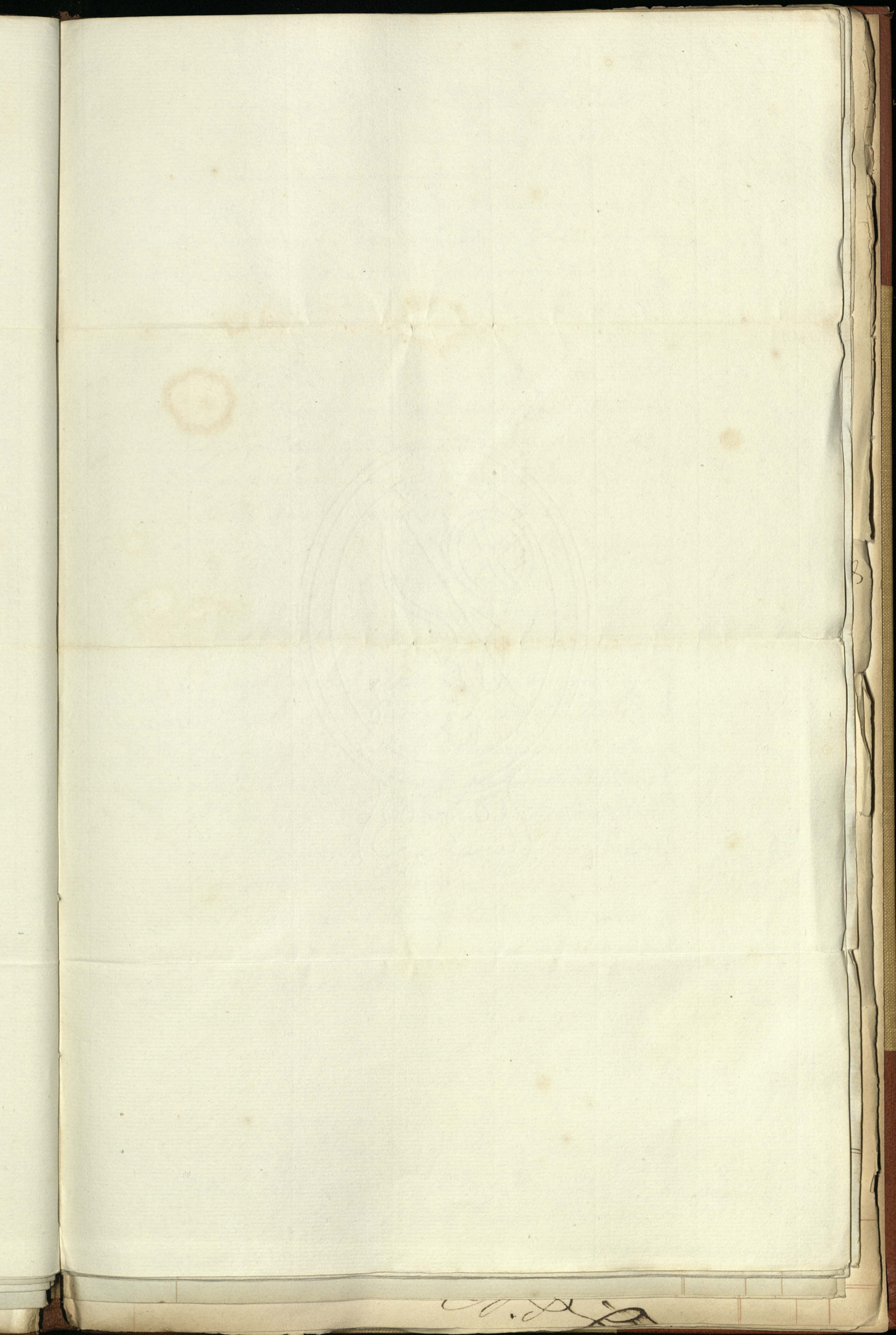
