My dearest Son, I am extremely sorry at  
all times to be deprived of the Pleasure of  
Y<sup>r</sup> Company, but particularly so when that  
Absence is caused by indisposition. I hope  
that a little Care & Prudence will soon re-  
cover You again & that I shall have the  
Pleasure of seeing You on Friday. The  
Co<sup>ch</sup> commonly goes to Town by 12. but I must  
mention a Circumstance which will  
oblige me to leave You immediately after  
that Friday between one & two being fixed  
for me to go & take Possession of Frog  
more which has already been delayed some  
time on account of Our Absence from Windsor  
& cannot be protracted any farther. Therefore

I cannot stay longer than the 1<sup>st</sup>, as  
Our time ~~will~~ <sup>must</sup> be very short, would  
not perhaps suit you better to come another  
day when we shall have more leisure  
Particularly as there is a chance of my  
going out in the open Chaise with the  
1<sup>st</sup>. I hope to hear that you  
are better, news in which nobody more  
sincerely rejoices in than
