be very agreeable to Him. I am
very so say that this is all I
can do, for the constant burry the
King is in at Present with business
in the Day, & rising in the Morning

has never afforded me an opportunity
of conversing with Him. & my last
Troyal of obtaining a conversation
at Frogmore where I proposed a
dinner on purpose for that account
was frustrated by the badness of
the Evening.

Y^r Sisters at Windsor are all
very well, & the Physicians think
Sophia also mending. I hope You
are well Yourself, & lucky in
meeting with good Horses which
every body wishes to get & Nobody
can find, at least, the Officers say so.
