My dearest Son. I am sorry that by a mistake of my Page who carried Y^r letter to Elizabeth we were not informed of one of Y^r Servants being come with it till past 9. last Night. I desired Him ^{fore} to stay till this Morning that I might write a few lines though I have not much to say. Permits me however to explain that I am convinced of the Kings desire that You should be Married as soon as it is possible by the Manner in which He talks. I know He has send for several Papers to make Himself Master of every Eligeth that He may give directions to Lord Salisbury, & was so kind as to direct me about getting all proper information concerning the Princesses Drefs indeed He saw Mrs Spilsbury Himself. & told Us when we were together that He had now ordered Lord Malmesbury to send an immediate Answer when the Princess could set Out.

I have appointed Mrs Beavery & Spilsbury on Wednesday next to meet me at the Queens House by 12. with a Doll. The former is to undertake the whole of for Madame La Future, as the only Person capable to Command as many Handsomen shall want to accomplish it in Time. & that it may be soon is what even You cannot wish more ardently.
