My dearest Son. According to yr Desire I have the pleasure to Inform You that the latest Day for the Wedding may be the 18th of this Month. which I suppose will suit all parties well. I have settled for the Prince of Cobourg to come to Windsor next Thursday & if the 18th is fixed upon by You of which you will be kind enough to Inform Me if possible by to Morrow before I go out of Town I mean please God to come to Town on Easter Sunday, & to have on the Tuesday laid out Charlottes Trousseaux for You to give yr Sanction, & then to return to Windsor the Day after the Marriage.

I am in hourly Expectation of an answer from Miss Coats which is the only thing that remains still to be sure of, & then I flatter Myself

You will feel truly Satisfyed in the Proper
choice You have made in the Persons about
Her.

I shall be glad if You will send by
Bloomfield to Morrow Morning by Twelve
a Plover with the answer to this Letter.

I should not have been troublesome
with a letter so soon after we had seen one written
so lately, but as I am sure You must be anxious
to see the conclusion of this Hurry I thought
My Information could not be sent too ^{early} soon.
