sending his Majesty a letter which he
has just received from Mr Robinson
containing an account of this day's
transactions in the City. The Corporation,
as Lord North said, has gone against
us, but a subscription among the merchants
is begun, which is likely to be very considerable,
& if assisted by the personal activity & exertions
of the Friends of Government, may, in this
our Capital, & its populous neighbourhood,
greatly contribute to recruit the Army.
