agreed that orders be sent to admiral
Parker representing that Information
has been received that the French
West India Islands within his Command
are liable to an Impression from the
British Home. and that it may be
expedient for him to make such an
attack. That Notice should be sent
to the Respective Governors of the
Neutral Settlements, that all such
French

French Islands or any of them upon
which such attack shall be meditated
are to be considered as Invested, and
that all Provisions and other Relief
sent to any of them in that Situation
will be considered as Contraband and
confiscated accordingly.

It having been discussed whether
orders should be sent to the Lord
Trent to adjourn the Court forthwith
for three weeks it was resolved to
wait till further Letters were rec^d from
him.
