The whole tenour of Lord North's conduct from the Hour he accepted the Post he now fills is a Surety to Me that he will not expect an immediate answer on so very material an event as the one he alludes to in his letter that I have just found on my Table; I cannot help just adding that the Resolutions come to in the Committee last Night and already Reported to the House can by no means be looked on as personal to Him; wish I did not feel at whom they are personally levelled.
