Camp at Ashdown Forest
August eighth 1793.

Sir

I am honoured with Your
Royal Highness's Letter of this Day's
Date inclosing the weekly State of the
10th or Prince of Wales's own Regiment
of Light Dragoons, and a Representation
made to Your Royal Highness by Lieuten^t.
Colonel Newton for an additional Allowance
of oats which Your Royal Highness is
pleas'd to recommend. I have in

Lt. Colonel Newton's Request with
Your Royal Highness's Letter to
Lord Amherst, and added that under
the circumstances mentioned by Lt.
Colonel Newton I think an addition
of two Pounds of oats per Day is very
necessary. I shall immediately acquaint
the Commissary General of Lt. Colonel
Newton's Complaint as to the Quality
of the Forage & in the mean Time direct
the Contractor to see that better is
