My Dearest Brother

I take the first opportunity I have
of writing to You to inform You that the Wounds I have
received are not at all dangerous and of very little consequence.
Probably You may have heard of it already by some Report
or other; and I hope You have not been alarmed at it. You
will be perhaps surpris'd to find I am at this Place, I arriv'd
here last night at about 10 O'Clock. from Turnes where
I had arriv'd the Day before from Conyngstone. I quitted
the ^{last} Place upon the News of the Handoveries being

attacked; I forced to retreat. I was advised then to
 retire; I came here taking it to be the safest place,
 and from whence I got the freshest News. Sr Kennedy
 who was extremely civile to me at times arrived here to
 night; I brought me the News that Frederick & Great
 are perfectly well, Frederick is retired from
 before Dunbar to Swines; but I suppose he will
 soon take another Position. The combined Army is
 therefore now together: according to a new report
 from an Officer who is just arrived from Swines;
 the combined Army had attacked; the French were
 retreating. The Losses were here but prodigious
 and the Battalion which had the Honour
 to command is probably quite ruined.
